We are campaigning for a railway station in Kenilworth and the train service our town deserves.

So that the citizens of Kenilworth can benefit from a mode of transport that otherwise serves only to cut the town in two.

ASK How?

In a positive manner we will make sure the opinions of those in favour of the station are given their due weight in the planning process.

Thanks to all who have registered support for ASK, campaigning for a railway station for Kenilworth. This newsletter advises you of both progress to date and future events.

Events We held a well attended public meeting for supporters in Spring, and following this a group of people have met regularly to continue the campaign work. During the year, the ASK campaign have attended the Lions Show in Abbey Fields, and the Car-Free day in Abbey End. This has allowed us to gain further support and publicity, and also given opportunities to discuss the station with the occasional person who is less enthusiastic. Coming up soon, we shall have a stand at the switch-on of the Kenilworth Christmas lights on Friday 26 November, and look forward to meeting many existing and new supporters then. We are also planning to hold a public meeting in the Spring of 2005 and will contact you again before then with further details. We look forward to your support for that event.

Publicity The proposed station and the ASK campaign have featured in the *Kenilworth Weekly News* on several occasions. The increased awareness has allowed us to build up a list of several hundred supporters, both within the town and outside, showing there is demand for a station for residents and visitors alike. Our website at www.kenilworthstation.org.uk is under development, and we hope to include further material there in the near future. Our publicity leaflet has been amended and is being circulated widely. We have also maintained contact with other appropriate organisations including rail user groups and local and national government.

General Thanks again for your support, and please continue to remind others of the need for a station in Kenilworth, inviting them to register their support for the station with ASK. A form for new supporters is included below, but if you have already registered support, there is no need to do so again. Also contact your elected representatives and ask them why we don't have the station we were promised.
